In the evening we had a dinner in social enterprise DIFFERENT. It is a restaurant in the total dark, the only one in Poland served by blind waiters. The restaurant in the dark introduces its guests to the world of the blind, where the visual barrier is not an obstacle, but a stimulus for the development of the other senses.

The next day we met in other branch of WCK to see some more good practices and have an Oxford style debate in the company of young Polish students. We took some participants from our group and moved them with student to discuss.

We had 4 groups - proposition, opposition and judges. And of course the audience. The Moderator was the guardian of order and was leading the hole process of debate.

The debate was very interesting and it wasn't easy to decide about the winning team. The judges decided that proposition team was more convincing, What is surprising most of the young people were against our resolution. But the way they were arguing and revealing their thoughts showed that young people can be really mature and engaged in social issues.
