Participants arrived in Velenje, in the hotel Razgoršek, where we had a welcome dinner.


20.04.2023

On Wednesday we start a day in Youth center Velenje, where we prepared presentation of our programs, activies and EU projects (konS, European Solidarity Corps and Erasmus+Youth Exchanges. EU for citizens). After that we visited our other infrastracture and met our employee in multimedia center Kunigunda, in new Pekarna in Old town, project konS office. We shared experiences and good practices on youth projects.





Then we visited Municipality Velenje, where we had dialogues with local experts. First our deputy mayor, Aleksandra Vasiljević, greet our delegates, then we met the leader of the Office for Economic Development and Restructuring, Helena knez, she prepared presentation about important EU projects and leader of the Office of Social Affairs, Marko Pritržnik, he prepered presentation of the city and his future challanges.





After that we went in Youth cultural club eMCe plac, unique product of close cooperation between the Youth Center Velenje and Student Club. The greatest added value of the club is to maintain principle: Youth for youth. Young people actively participate in program proposals in all areas, participate in the organization and implementation of events and activities, and have the opportunity to co-create a program that interests them and gain knowledge and experience in this field.





Next action was a Street Actions: "Local Europe" where delegates gathers in groups and went around the city to make short video interviews with local citizens about EU youth policies. They asked them various questions, for example: As a citizen of EU, what are the topics that worries you the most right now? What actions, politics or benefits should EU bring to the table to stay united? What are the beneficts for Youngsters?



We ended first day with the dinner at little touristic farm Apat with good local food, we also invited two student, one, Yehor, from Ukraine and second, Uroš, from Serbia, to share the stories and their view of what EU can offer to youngsters.

21. 4. 2023

Second day we started with Workshop in Vila Bianca. It was moderated by journalist and longtime external colleague from Youth center Velenje, Tina Felicijan. Partners were in groups and together exploring how to implement strategies, that we presented so far, in their own municipality lab.





Then we went in Old town Velenje, where colleagues from the Municipality of Velenje, Vanesa and Domen, who are working on this project, presented Revitalization of the degraded urban part of the city that was financed by European Union. This is our good practice, that our town is really proud of. We took participants to family business Šili testenine, they are making delicious homemade pasta. Then we went to barber shop, creative center Čuk, in The Museum - House of Minerals, and our last stop was Pekarna, where we saw the edited movie about yesterdays Street actions.

We organized sightseeing tour of the city and lakes with an accredited tourist guide. We went to Vista, on the redevelopment area, which is located in a degraded urban area, which was created as a result of mining activity. The project was co-financed by the European Union from the European Fund for Regional Development.

We organized free entry at Castle Velenje for everybody.

After that we had a farewell dinner.
