08/09/2022

The participants attended the Municipal Youth Center located in the center of Bucharest where at the beginning of the morning, Mr. Daniel Enachescu, welcomed the participants of the first event of the FUTUREU project. Later on, Mrs. Anamaria Moisa held a presentation about how the Europe citizens' initiative works – she explained how those initiatives became a reality, the process and how exactly the message reaches the main beneficiaries. In this way, the participants were able to learn about other participation mechanisms, especially for young people, in which they can play a leading role within the European framework. Several representatives of the National Union of Romanian Students were also present at this seminar.

In the afternoon, the participants had the opportunity to visit the European Parliament Information Bureau (House of Europe) where they found out more information about local European initiatives and about how young people can have local initiatives.

The visit took place in the form of a dialogue, both between the young people, the partner delegations, and between the Europarl Romania representatives.

After the visit, the participants returned to the Municipal Youth Center where local good initiatives promoting citizens participation were debated, such as Bucharest citizen initiatives fair. Mr. Daniel Enachescu explained to the attendees their main characteristics and functionalities at Bucharest local reality.

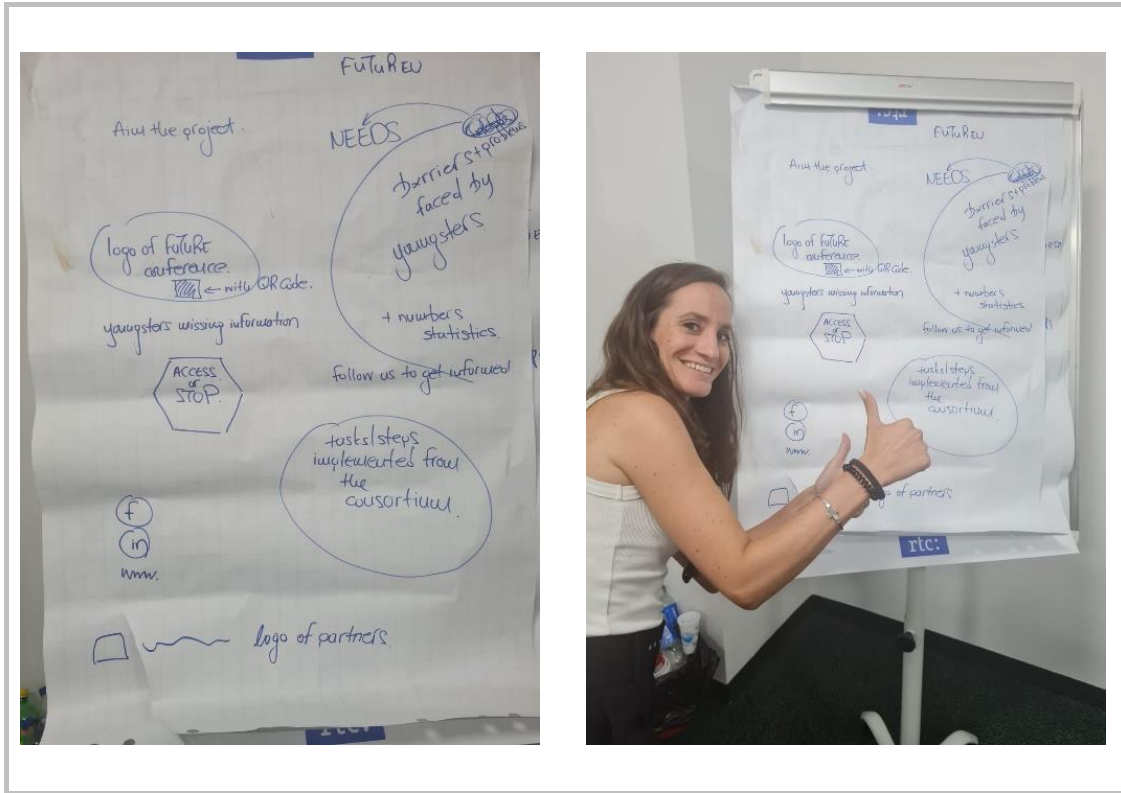
Later in the morning, we had a dynamic workshop in which all partners shared some examples about their local activities and how they promote citizens participation.
